### 1) **Starting the meeting - Torsten**

The following was noted:

- Ingemar has made a question - template
- Torsten has talked to Antoine regarding BoK coordination, Antoine has mapped EN15628 and EN17007 against the BoK subjects
- Questions will be as discussed earlier on the level of Minimum Knowledge (multiple choice question), Skills and Competences.
- Production of questions could start soon

### 2) **Production of questions**

The following was noted:

- In the Excel sheet Torsten sent before the meeting, there is a template for creating questions. The document uses the words "Main subject", "Superior subject" and "Subject". The Swedish team found "EN15628 - Column Minimum skill" not a good enough basis for question creation and have therefore created a set of their own subjects. This approach has however not been agreed upon by this project group, as at our meeting in Stockholm it was decided to start creating the questions from EN15628, minimum knowledge column.
- We will start with 15 items from EN15628 - Minimum knowledge column and start creating questions using the template from Ingemar, Subject = Cell from EN15628 minimum knowledge column, Main Subject and Superior Subject kept empty.
  - Sweden will plan and execute this pilot before next meeting.
  - Others should experiment.
- What kind of software structure / platform do we need to collect the questions with all references needed? Can we use a solution that is already available and/or should we make our own. Possibly we can use the Moodle platform, but it may not be good for handling a mass of questions in different languages.

- Current softwares used in Finland and Sweden should be looked at
