1) A general status update (Erasmus+ Follow up of MCQ)

The following was noted:

- Finland: 79 MCQ, more on the way including OQ
- Czech republic: 148 MCQ and 30 OQ.
- Hungary: 111 MCQ and more on the way
- Iceland: 50 MCQ, more on the way, and 5 OQ. Plan to make the team bigger
- Slovenia: 27 MCQ
- Sweden: 286 MCQ, more on the way.

2) Review of the previous protocol

As before, the idea is to have two levels exam, one MCQ for the “Knowledge passport” and the second also based on skills and competence, MCQ and OQ.

The result of this project should be of value for all. The idea is on the table that this consortium will hand the question database over to EFNMS with a written contract

explaining how the database will be kept and maintained, it is assumed that ECC will play a big role there. No one has disagreed with this.

It was also noted that this project has first and foremost to do with creating questions. Further work will be needed for defining all needed processes.

As before, the subject framework is open for modification.

3) Timetable and economy

We are more or less following the timetable.. The payment #2 period will end depends on the process, e.g. the payment periods are tied to the flow of the project. There has been discussions about the multiplier events. All are encouraged to inform Torsten about plans regarding such events.

4) Updated qualifications

Torsten sent out suggestions regarding changes to the subject framework, but did not get any feedback so he assumes that no one disagrees. The suggestion includes:

- Adding some general subjects for general questions
- Some title changes

Everyone is asked to send (further) proposed changes to Torsten before our next meeting.

5) Development of questions

- Areas that need more cover.
- The distribution of work. How can we distribute the work better? It was agreed that all teams can call for assistance in certain areas/subjects/chapters, please list the subjects and send to Torsten. The teams can also make use of their expertise in certain areas and (offer to) add questions in those areas.
- Multiple choice and open questions.

It was suggested that everyone working on creating questions should sign a paper stating that he/she will treat the questions/data according to suggested rules/guidelines.

It was also suggested that we have to make sure we are allowed to use the standards and refer to the standards in line with the ideas we are working on.

6) Committee involvement

Torsten introduced a draft letter to EFNMS committee chairmans, cc to EFNMS board. Torsten will send the draft to all and ask for feedback within this week. It will be discussed at our next status meeting, next Monday.

7) The QVCMP Web page

We still do not have a project web page with structure and content. It was suggested to start with a minimum version, including the project's objectives.
